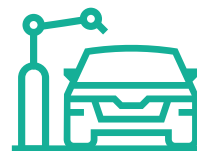


# 15,000,000 VEHICLES

HAVE BEEN PRODUCED AT ŠKODA AUTO'S PLANT IN MLADÁ BOLESLAV SINCE 1905

The Mladá Boleslav plant combines a long tradition of excellence with progressive manufacturing processes. The plant was modernised last year and contains **the Group's only production line on which both** the combustion engine vehicles (built on the MQB platform) and the ŠKODA ENYAQ iV (an all-electric car built on the new MEB platform) can be manufactured alongside one another.

In addition to producing 6 models, the Mladá Boleslav site manufactures engines, gearboxes, axles and high-voltage traction batteries for ŠKODA, as well as for other Volkswagen Group brands.

## DID YOU KNOW... ?



The plant's new paint shop is one of the most environmentally friendly sites of its kind in Europe. By **recycling**

**80% of air** used for its operation, the paint shop substantially reduces its air treatment demands. And in comparison with the old paint shop, the emissions of organic substances are now 36% lower and the drying-relevant energy consumption has been reduced by 20%.



Manual gearboxes designated as MQ 100 and MQ 200

are part of Mladá Boleslav's long-standing production programme. Like traction batteries for plug-in hybrids, these manual gearboxes are used in a number of **models from other Volkswagen Group brands.**



Mladá Boleslav also manufactures traction batteries

for plug-in hybrids. In fact, the plant has produced **more than 100,000 batteries** of this type in the first 15 months since the production launch in 2019.

## PRODUCTION HISTORY

Today, ŠKODA vehicles are manufactured near the original factory whose roots date back to 1898 – this is where Laurin & Klement started assembling their bicycles and motorcycles. Some of the original premises have been preserved and are currently used by the ŠKODA Museum.
